Jewelry sale will benefit youth ministries



In his 2021 Episcopal Address, Bishop Devadhar recommended the book *Faith After Doubt: Why Your Beliefs Stopped Working and What to Do About It* to clergy and laity of the New England Conference.

The bishop is pleased to welcome the book's author, Brian D. McLaren, to the NEAC for a four-session online discussion of this book that the bishop called "important and insightful."

In his address Bishop Devadhar said, "McLaren invites us to a future of hope. He invites us to transform our weariness into constructive collaborations with fellow Christians. He invites us to invest in the church of the future."

Registration is open until Sept. 9. Space is limited.




